

Resolution 2003-01

A resolution establishing an education reform task force

Whereas, the Brownsville Chamber of Commerce Board of Directors has been briefed on various issues relating to the federal “No Child Left Behind” legislation, and

Whereas, this legislation has important implications for the students, faculty and administrators of public schools in Brownsville, and

Whereas, the Board of Directors wished to support excellence in education for all the children of Brownsville, and

Whereas, successful implementation of “No Child Left Behind” legislation will be of great economic and social benefit to Brownsville.

Be it therefore resolved, the Board of Directors hereby establishes an education reform task force to provide, develop and encourage community support for excellence in education, using appropriate methods and resources, and

It is further resolved, the task force will provide regular reports, no less than semi-annually, to the Board, and

It is further resolved, it is anticipated the task force will have an operational life of three years.
